## 1- GENERAL REGULATIONS

- 1.1- Associations and athletes from any organization may register;
- 1.2- The associations may register the number of athletes they wish per category;
- 1.3- Individual competition of *Shiai Kata* and *Shiai Kumite modalities*;
- 1.4- The calculation method will be by simple eliminations, without repechage and without dispute for 3rd place;
- 1.5- The overall ranking will be based on the Olympic medal counting model. the eventual  
The tiebreaker will be in favor of the team with the highest number of athletes.

## 2- KATA RULES

- 2.1- It will be done by *koha-ku* methodology (voting by white and red flags);
- 2.2- Athletes from categories up to green belt will only be able to perform any of the *kata* of the *Shitei* phase that appear in table 1 (attached on page 5) and the repetition of the same *kata* in all rounds will be allowed;
- 2.3- Athletes from the purple to black belt categories must perform their *kata* according to the number of rounds in table 1 (attached on page 6), which depends on the number of athletes per category:
  - 2.3.1- Up to 4 athletes: single round *Tokui* ;
  - 2.3.2- 5/8 athletes: 1st round *Sentei*, 2nd round *Tokui*;
  - 2.3.3- 9/16 athletes: 1st round *Shitei*, 2nd round *Sentei*, 3rd round *Tokui*;
  - 2.3.4- 17/32 athletes: 1st round *Shitei*, 2nd round *Shitei*, 3rd round *Sentei*, 4th round *Tokui*;
  - 2.3.5- 33/64 athletes: 1st round *Shitei*, 2nd rod. *Shitei*, 3rd rod. *Shitei*, 4th rod. *Sat down*, 5th rod. *Tokui*.

## 3- KUMITE RULES

- 3.1- *Shobu sanbon* methodology (combination of *waza-ari* and *ippon*);
- 3.2- The combat time will be timed according to the following classes:
  - 3.2.1- Under 8, Under 10, Under 12, Under 14, Cadet, Junior and Under 21 2min
  - 3.2.2- Senior and Master .....3min
- 3.3- The athlete must wear, obligatorily, belts (white and red), gloves, mouthguard and tibia and foot protectors, otherwise he will be subject to disqualification. The use of a strainer will be optional, but recommended;
  - 3.3.1- The use of the head protector will not be allowed.
- 3.4- In addition to complying with the rules, there will be emergency medical care on the day and place of the competition.



#### 4- TECHNICIANS AND DELEGATES

- 4.1- Must be properly identified by the uniform of his delegation;
- 4.2- In addition to the referees, support staff and athletes from the named categories, only one coach per mat area, expressly identified with his uniform, can remain on the court and must occupy the space reserved for them;
- 4.3- Any undue behavior by the crowd, coach, delegate or athlete will result in disqualification of the same or even the participating association;
- 4.4- Under no circumstances will the following be tolerated: request for refund of the registration fee or attitudes that disagree with the *Reigi Saho* (code of etiquette and decorum), which is known to safeguard the fundamental ethical values of the honor and prestige of Karate-Do;
- 4.5- All participants (public, athletes, coaches and referees) who come to exercise any functions in this event must be aware of these Regulations.

#### 5- ATHLETES

- 5.1- Weigh-in: It will only take place in case of doubt upon request of the referee, as long as the athlete has not yet fought and there will be no tolerance. The athlete may be relocated to his correct category if this has not been started, otherwise he will be disqualified due to the club's registration error;
- 5.2- Documentation: any athlete must provide proof of age with photo. If you do not present when requested by the organization, you will be disqualified;
- 5.3- Graduation: as this competition is open to athletes with and without ties to federations and/or styles schools, the control over their graduations will be guided by the ethics and responsibility of their respective coaches, delegates and teachers;
- 5.4- Attire: white *karate-gi*, white and red belts, gloves, mouthguard and ear protectors tibia and foot.

#### 6- REFEREES

- 6.1- The arbitration will be composed by CNK/WKC referees and invited by the organization of the event;
- 6.2- Each participating entity may register up to five arbitrators, who will be supervised from CNK/WKC;
- 6.3- The referees must wear a navy blue jacket, plain white shirt, blue tie, plain gray pants, black shoes and black socks.

#### 7- TECHNICAL CONGRESS

- 7.1- It will be given virtually through the *website* [www.sistemaronin.com](http://www.sistemaronin.com) and participation is mandatory. The absence of representation of the association in the Virtual Technical Congress (CTV) will imply the impossibility of future questions;
- 7.2- Except for administrative error, under no circumstances will changes be made to the competition keys after the end of the CTV. Collaboration is requested for the smooth running of the event;
- 7.3- Any cases omitted from this Regulation will be resolved by the event organizer.



## 8- AWARDS

- 8.1- The first three classified associations will receive personalized trophies;
- 8.2- The association with the highest number of athletes will receive a trophy, except for associations hostesses;
- 8.3- They will be awarded with exclusive personalized medals, allusive to the event, the first place, the second place and two third places of each category;
- 8.4- Athletes will be awarded immediately at the end of each category.

## 9- REGISTRATION

- 9.1- Until November 19, 2023, Wednesday, to be carried out exclusively through the *online* form available at [www.sistemaronin.com](http://www.sistemaronin.com)
- 9.2- In order to avoid the unnecessary exchange of categories, which makes it difficult for the organization to plan for awards, general and, mainly, individual calculations, we request attention regarding the codes of the athletes' categories. We count on your collaboration;
- 9.3- We point out that a fine of R\$ 20.00 will be charged for each of the corrections that may eventually be held on the day of the event;
- 9.4- The categories are attached on pages. 6 and 7 of this invitation.
